Shark Caddis Larva

Rev 20141104

Materials Needed:

Hook: Curved hook any kind of model for caddis patterns

Thread: Black 6/0

Body: Yellow Antron yarn and hare's under fur dubbing hair

Thorax: Two peacock herl (or dark brown Antron)



Put the hook with the bead on it in the vice and tie on the thread

Tie the Creamy yellow Antron yarn at the bead and cover it back to the curve of the hook



After that wrap the yarn to the bead and back to the curve to have a thicker foundation (If you use the fly as a Czech nymph - if you want it heavy - you may want to wrap a heavy wire instead of the yarn)



Make a loop by splitting the end of the Antron.



After that take some hare's under fur (the soft part of the hair) and put it in the loop.

Move thread forward to bead.

Twist loop.



Wrap the twisted yarn around the hook to the bead, and you will get the segmented body.



Fix two peacock herls behind the bead (or use dark brown Antron dubbed on the thread)

Wrap the herl and fix behind the bead (or wrap the Antron dubbing).

Whip finish, add some head cement and the fly is done.
